

Sixth Form Dress Code

Members of Trinity Academy Sixth Form are expected to wear a professional standard of dress. Students **must** dress in business or office attire. Clothes must be smart, modest and safe, and students must avoid displaying extremes of fashion.

Students are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

Item/s	Requirement/s
Shirt	• Button up shirt • Shirt always to be tucked into skirt or trousers
Blouse/Top	• Shoulders must be covered • Not tight-fitting
Trousers	• Tailored, full-length trousers
Skirt/Dress	• To be worn at knee-length • Must not be tightly-fitted
Shoes	• Formal shoes • All black trainers
Lanyard	• Must always be visible
Outdoor Jackets/Coats	• Not to be worn within the school buildings
The following are unacceptable:	• Hoodie • Vest tops • Jogging bottoms • Shorts (except in very hot weather) • Flip Flops • Trainers (All black trainers are acceptable) • High heels higher than 4cms • Jeans of any sort • Leggings/Jeggings/Lycra • Sportswear and clothes with big graphics • Brightly coloured hair dye • Visible tattoos or body piercings • Excessively long nails

The Head of Sixth Form is the ultimate judge of acceptability regarding dress code.

The Academy reserves the right to issue further guidance and clarification if it proves necessary to do so.

Trinity Academy reserves the right to send Sixth Form students home without prior notification if they do not abide by the agreed dress code.
